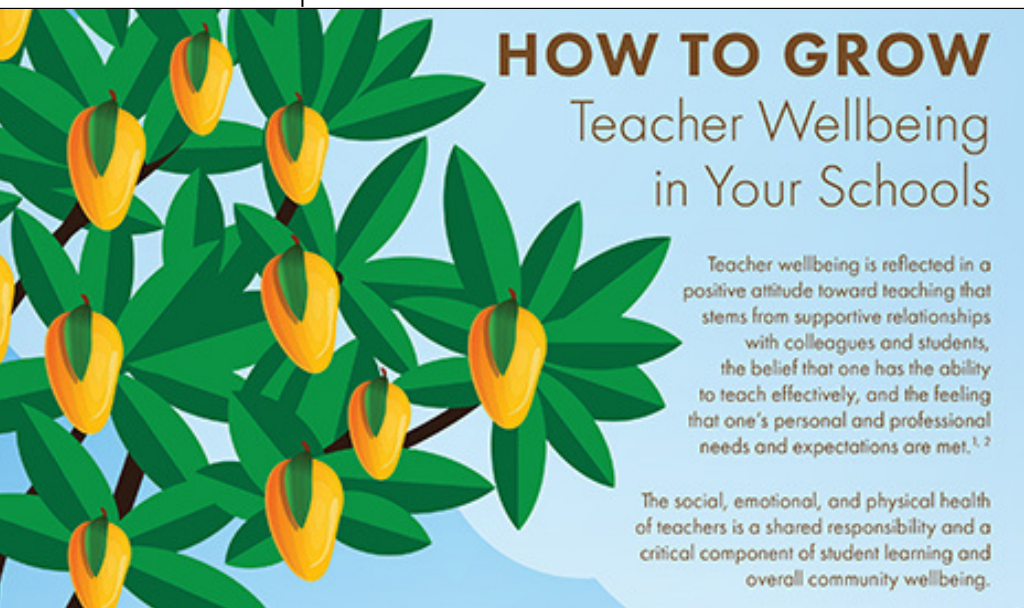

A: "If you do what you love, you'll never work a day in your life". My classes with my students are a real stress-buster. Having said that, I do keep some personal time earmarked – weekends, holidays & the like.
5. Anything crazy about you...
A: How I buy new books by the dozen, but just keep re-reading my old favorites'.
6. Where do you see yourself in this field in the future?
A: Oh, in so many places – teaching a kindergarten class, as a professor in a university, an English language instructor like the one in the movie "English Vinglish".
7. If not education, then... where would you be?
A: Maybe a movie critic. Or in a publishing house. Anything to do with words and stories.
8. What do you do to rejuvenate and inspire yourself?
A: I read and watch movies. A lot!
9. Your message for fellow educators...
A: This is such an incredible responsibility – educating young minds. I'd say teach kids imagining a future where if you have to live with them, you'd be happy with what they've learnt and the individuals they've become.

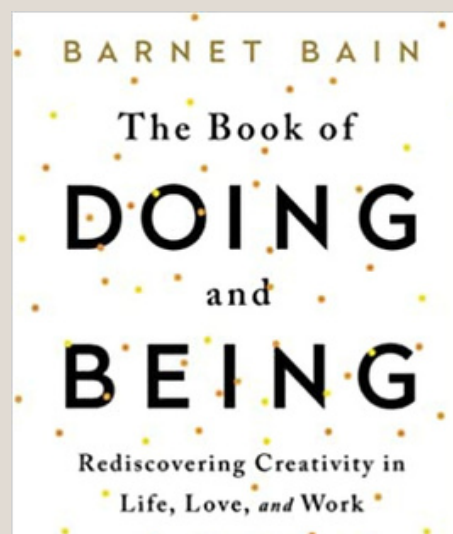
The Book of Being and Doing
